Dear Ms. Moore:

This letter is in response to your communication sent on April 20, 2011.

As I mentioned to you on the phone, it is very important to understand that this is not a loan. You issued bonds that we purchased for our investment portfolio. As such, bonds have very specific payment instructions and do not offer lots of flexibility.

Harris is willing to allow you to call seven bond maturities with maturity dates from January 1, 2022 to January 1, 2028. We will allow the call at par value plus accrued interest. The face amount of these bonds is \$395,000.00 and accrued interest as of May 31, 2011 will be \$7,055.21. This results in a total payment on Tuesday, May 31, 2011 of \$402,055.21.

This would leave \$285,000.00 in face value of bonds remaining with maturities from January 1, 2012 to January 1, 2021. The bank cannot accept monthly payments on these bonds. As you accumulate funds per the Intergovernmental Agreement, we may be willing to entertain another proposal to call additional bond maturities.

The trustee for the bond issue is as follows:

The Bank of New York Mellon Attn: Caresse Tankersley 2001 Bryan St., 11th Floor Dallas, TX 75201

The trustee will require a letter of direction from Grafton Township Road & Bridge instructing them to call the Certificates (on letterhead and signed by an authorized signer). In addition, they will require an Incumbency Certificate completed by Grafton Township Road & Bridge on letterhead. The person who signs the direction letter should be on the top portion of the Incumbency Certificate and another authorized signer should attest to their signature. In turn, Harris will supply a letter allowing the early redemption of the Certificates and an Incumbency Certificate by Harris on letterhead.



In addition, we will require a signed copy of the Intergovernmental Agreement and a resolution passed by the Grafton Township Road & Bridge Board authorizing the early redemption (and minutes showing the adoption of the resolution).

The trustee will provide information for the wire transfer of the funds.

Please contact me when the necessary resolution has been passed and we can move forward in the process.
